RELEASE OF LIABILITY GOVERNING THE USE OF A MT. ASHLAND GOLD SEASON PASS

1. GOLD SEASON PASS Holder must be a licensed Business.
2. A Gold Season Pass is valid for all sessions of normal operation including night skiing.
3. If a Gold Season Pass is forgotten, a lift Ticket MUST BE PURCHASED.
4. A Gold Season Pass Holder agrees to notify MT. ASHLAND IMMEDIATELY if a pass is lost. A Charge of \$50.00 will be made for the issuance of a new pass. A deteriorated or cracked pass will be replaced at no charge.
5. A Gold Season Pass is NOT REFUNDABLE. No refunds will be made in the event any Gold Season Pass Holder(s) is unable, for any reason, to use the SEASON PASS during the 2017-2018 ski season.
6. A GOLD SEASON PASS HOLDER and users agree to display the SEASON PASS on the OUTSIDE of his/her clothing, IN FULL VIEW when using the lift facilities.
7. A GOLD SEASON PASS HOLDER AGREES TO OBSERVE ALL U.S. FOREST SERVICE REGULATIONS. As well, pass holders agree to observe all rules and procedures of MT. ASHLAND pertaining to the use of the SKI AREA and its facilities and to observe the "SKIERS RESPONSIBILITY CODE" and ski ONLY within the boundaries and not into CLOSED areas. VIOLATION of these policies may result in suspension or confiscation of pass.
8. The undersigned agree(s) to abide by the duties of skiers pursuant to ORS 30.985, which include but are not limited to the following:
 - a) Skiers who ski in any area not designated for skiing within the permit area assume the inherent risks thereof.
 - b) Skiers shall be the sole judges of the limits their skills and their ability to meet and overcome the inherent risks of skiing and shall maintain reasonable control of speed and course.
 - c) Skiers shall abide by the direction and instructions of the ski area operator.
 - d) Skiers shall familiarize themselves with posted information on location and degree of difficulty of trails and slopes to the extent reasonably possible before skiing on any slope or trail.
 - e) Skiers shall not cross the uphill track of any surface lift except at points clearly designated by the ski are operator.
 - f) Skiers shall not overtake any other skier except in such a manner as to avoid contact and shall grant the right of way to the overtaken skier.
 - g) Skiers shall yield to other skiers when entering a trail or starting downhill.
 - h) Skiers must wear retention straps or other devices to prevent runaway skis.
 - i) Skiers shall not board rope tows, wire rope tows, j-bars, t-bars, ski lifts or other similar devices unless they have sufficient ability to use the devices, and skiers shall follow any written or verbal instructions that are given regarding the devices.
 - j) Skiers, when involved in a skiing accident, shall not depart from the ski area without leaving their names and addresses if reasonably possible.
 - k) A skier who is injured should, if reasonably possible, give notice of the injury to the ski area operator before leaving the ski area.
 - l) Skiers shall not embark or disembark from a ski lift except at designated area or by the authority of the ski area operator.
9. Violation of any of these terms and conditions may result in suspension and/or revocation of a Season Pass. A Season Pass may be revoked without refund at any time for misconduct or nuisance caused by the holder.
10. Release of liability and indemnity agreement. READ CAREFULLY.

IN CONSIDERATION FOR LIFT ACCESS AND USE OF ANY OTHER AREA FACILITIES AND PREMISES, I AGREE TO RELEASE AND INDEMNIFY MT. ASHLAND ASSOCIATION, DBA MT. ASHLAND ("MT. ASHLAND") FROM A NY AND ALL CLAIMS I MAY HAVE AGAINST MT. ASHLAND. THIS RELEASE INCLUDES CLAIMS ARISING FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, NEGLIGENCE BY MT. ASHLAND OR ITS EMPLOYEES OR AGENTS, THE INHERENT RISKS OF SKIING, THE USE OF SKI LIFTS, COLLISION WITH NATURAL OR MAN-MADE OBJECTS OR OTHER SKIERS, COLLISIONS WITH SNOWMOBILES AND SNOW GROOMING EQUIPMENT, USE OF AREA PREMISES AND TRAVEL WITHIN OR BEYOND AREA BOUNDARIES.

This agreement shall be governed by Oregon law and exclusive jurisdiction for any claim shall be in Jackson County, Oregon. If signing on behalf of a minor, the undersigned parent or legal guardian acknowledges that he/she is signing on behalf of the minor(s) and that the minor(s) shall be bound by all of the foregoing, including the Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement.
